



Stucco Cleaner

DESCRIPTION:

- A. El Rey Stucco Cleaner is a mild acid based product developed to remove efflorescence (white chalky residue), dirt, minerals, and many other stains from stucco, tile, grout, masonry and concrete surfaces.
- B. Meets requirements of the American National Standards Institute (ANSI) 108.
- C. Features and Benefits to using Stucco Cleaner are:
 - Dry granules are safer to transport and handle than liquid cleaners.
 - Dilutes in water and is a safer alternative than muratic acid
 - Enhances the long-term beauty of stucco, concrete or grout surfaces
 - Cleans efflorescence and dirt from finished stucco surfaces

USES:

Stucco Cleaner is ideal for cleaning existing stucco surfaces prior to re-stucco applications. Eliminates effects of efflorescence by neutralizing surface alkalinity.

COMPOSITION AND PHYSICAL PROPERTIES:

- A. Acid based stucco cleaner.

COVERAGE:

- A. Two pounds (0.9kg) of Stucco Cleaner Concentrate Granules mixed with five gallons of water cleans approximately 1000-1500 feet (305-457m) depending on severity of stain. Some hard to remove stains may require repeat applications.

PACKAGING:

Two US Pounds (0.9 Kilograms)
Eight US Pounds (3.6 Kilograms)

- A. Storage: Protect from heat and freezing at all times.
- B. Keep container closed when not in use.
- C. Shelf life: One year if protected from sun and freezing.

JOB PREPARATION

A. Preparation:

1. Test a small area first to assure desired results. Do not use if stucco or other cement products are not fully cured.
2. Protect surrounding plants and foliage from overspray and runoff.

B. Mixing:

1. Add 2 pounds (.91 kg) Stucco Cleaner Concentrate Granules slowly into five gallons of clean, warm water and stir until granules no longer dissolve.
2. For a lesser quantity, add 1 part (by volume) to 20 parts (by volume) of clean, warm water.

C. Application:

1. Saturate the surface to be cleaned with clean water then apply the Stucco Cleaner solution with a nonmetallic brush or plastic type garden sprayer and let stand for a few minutes.
2. Scrub with a Stiff nonmetallic brush until stain is removed. Be sure the resultant waste is thoroughly rinsed off or wet vacuumed from the surface.

Limitations:

1. Avoid inhalation of fine particulate dust when mixing this product.
2. Use in a well ventilated area.
3. Granules in solution is highly acidic, pH ≤ 1.0 , and can cause eye and skin burns and irritation of the nose, throat, and lungs. Do not get into eyes.
4. When handling, avoid contact with skin and clothing. Minimize exposure by wearing eye goggles, organic vapor respirator and rubber gloves.
